Promotion Criteria

- To ensure students have attained the required academic foundation to cope with the next level of learning

Sec 2 Express

Promoted to Sec 3 Express

Grade 6 in EL and attain 50% or higher in the overall percentage of all subjects combined

Lateral Transfer to Sec 3 Normal Academic

If student does not meet criteria for promotion, laterally transferred to

Sec 3 Normal Academic

Refer to P22 of Student Handbook



Promotion Criteria

- To ensure students have attained the required academic foundation to cope with the next level of learning


