## Be Prepared

 Wear full school uniform, i.e. school shirt with pants / skirt and shoes, and be properly groomed. Permission will need to be sought for exceptions.







## Be Prepared

- Drink sufficient water and eat healthily to avoid falling sick.

- Place your bag neatly at the front of the exam room.

- Be seated according to the seating plan.
- Once you are seated, place your entry proof and photo identification (FACE UP) on the top right-hand corner of your desk.
- Communication between candidates is STRICTLY NOT allowed at any time.









- You have the relevant supporting documents to support your application (e.g. medical report/statement from a qualified medical practitioner) to certify that you are unfit for the examination.

PE (Mr Hamzah) will get in touch with you to see if arrangements can be made for you to sit for the exam if you have been certified medically fit by a qualified medical practitioner to sit for the exam.


