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Key Pointers for Students on ITE's Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) for Admission to Nitec Courses

ALL N(T) students and N(A) students (who are not progressing to 5N(A) or repeating 4N(A)) are eligible for JIE.

Keen competition for Nitec and Higher Nitec courses, so use all 12 choices wisely!

Participation in Main Phase is key to secure a place in ITE!

If you are keen in the work & learn option, you may consider applying for the ITE Traineeship programme. Do apply in the Main Phase to avoid missing a place in ITE!

If you are unsuccessful in EAE, make sure you apply in Main Phase to avoid missing a place!

If you have received an additional letter, then you are eligible for the 3-year Nitec Programme (eNFP)

If you are eligible for eNFP, make sure you apply for the 2-year Nitec and 3-year Higher Nitec first before applying for eNFP!

The eNFP helps to build the necessary literacy and numeracy foundations that will enable you to successfully complete your Nitec course!

If you are counter-offered a course, accept it first before appealing for another course you may be more interested in!

2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered **before** applying in the **2nd Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase)** between **30 Dec 2022 to 4 Jan 2023**. The application results for the 2nd Phase will be known on **11 Jan 2023 at 9am**.
3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the **3rd Phase (Final Top-up Phase)** between **11 Jan to 19 Jan 2023 and 27 Jan to 8 Feb 2023** for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3rd Phase will be known between **16 Jan to 27 Jan 2023** and **27 Jan to 14 Feb 2023**.

Post-Results Release: Choosing your courses wisely

STEP 1

Consider your Values, Interests, Personality & Skills (VIPS) and how they align with options or courses you are eligible for.

STEP 2

Explore and research on options:

- Subject contents & syllabus / course objectives & modules
- Progression opportunities
- Career prospects

STEP 3

Consider chances of being posted into desired courses in JCs/MI, Polytechnics and/or ITE, using the *last aggregate scores as a reference.

*For last aggregate scores, refer to JAE/JIE booklet

STEP 4

Shortlist up to 12 choices, ensuring that you include at least a few choices* where you stand a high chance of being posted to.

STEP 5

Rank your 12 choices according to your preferences.

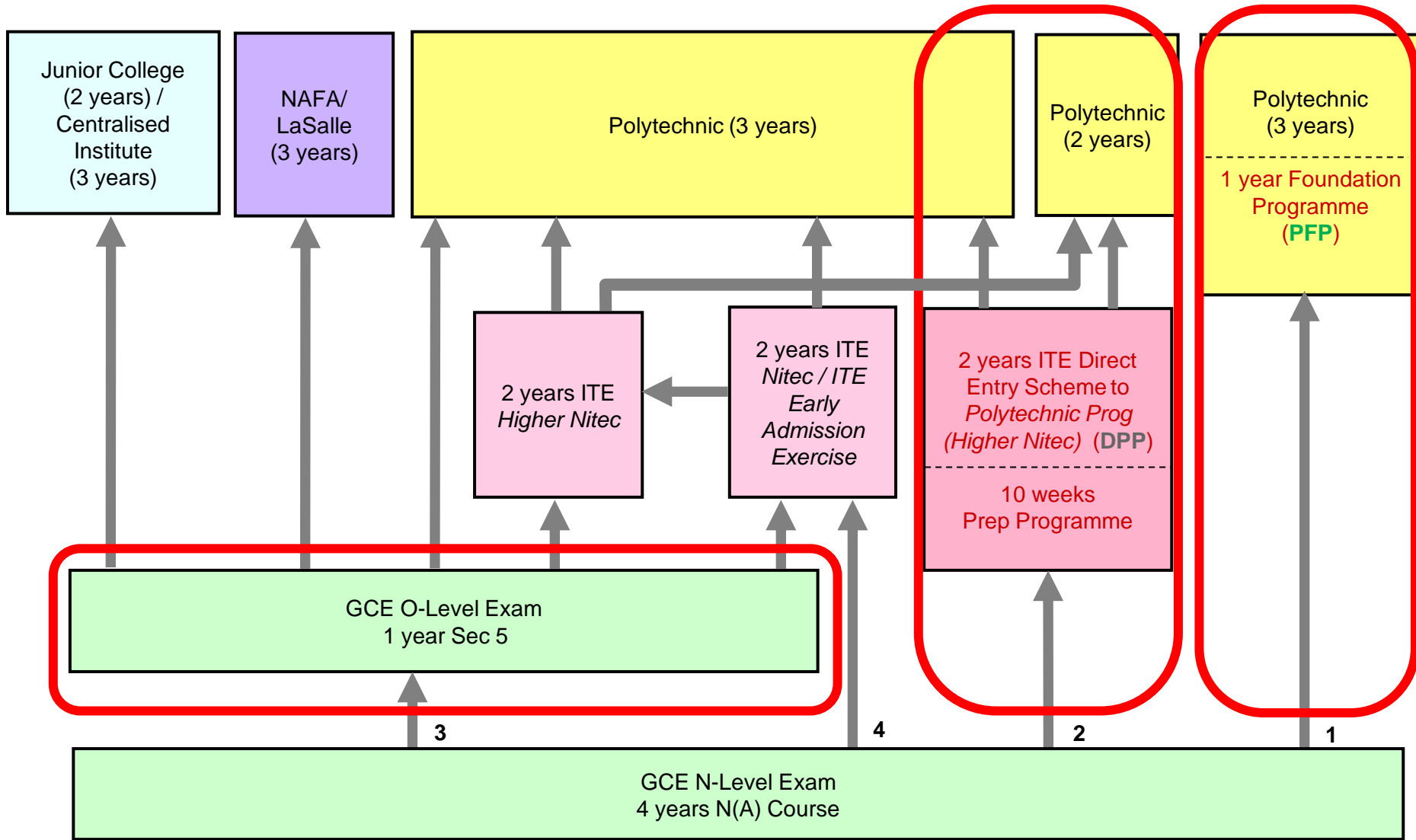

Pathway 1: ITE EAE

ITE EAE Offers to applicants

Students who accepted the offer in August and have received a **confirmed ITE EAE offer** would be indicated as “successful” and would be able to check the course and college that they are posted to.



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Pathway 1: ITE EAE

ITE EAE Offers to applicants

Applicants who have accepted **ITE EAE** offers and have received the Confirmation offers are to honour the offers. The Confirmation offers will be made known to the students during the release of the N-Level results.

Do not apply for 2-Year *Nitec and 3-Year Higher Nitec* courses for 2022 Joint Intake Exercise (JIE ITE). **You will not be eligible, as you already have a place through the EAE.**



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Pathway 1: ITE EAE

ITE EAE Offers to applicants

ITE will also be contacting students about the status of their ITE EAE offers via (i) mobile phones or (ii) electronic mail. However, in the event that students do not receive the updates from ITE due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g. mobile number has changed since ITE EAE application), they would still be able to check-in with their schools on their ITE EAE offer status.

ITE EAE Offers to applicants

Students who did not meet the minimum entry requirements (MERs) and had their **ITE EAE** offer revoked would be indicated as “unsuccessful”.

They are allowed to apply for the 2-Year *Nitec* and 3-Year *Higher Nitec* courses via the 2022 Joint Intake Exercise (JIE ITE).

DIRECT-ENTRY-SCHEME TO POLYTECHNIC PROGRAMME (DPP)

5 Things You Need to Know

1. What is the DPP?

- Prepares Sec 4N(A) students for progression into selected polytechnic diploma courses via a 2-year *Higher Nitec* programme at ITE, and a 10-week DPP preparatory course
 - Serves as an alternative to Sec 5
- Students who attain required *Higher Nitec* GPA scores are guaranteed a place in one of the polytechnic diploma courses mapped to the *Higher Nitec* course. (Refer to <https://www.ite.edu.sg/admissions/full-time-courses/higher-nitec-dpp> for course mapping.)
- About 1,200 places offered across 18 *Higher Nitec* courses

2. Am I Eligible for DPP 2023?

- Sec 4N(A) student who has sat for GCE N-Level exams in 2022
 - Obtained ELMAB3 aggregate of 19 points or less (before deduction of CCA bonus points)
 - Meet subject-specific entry requirements
- If you can check all 3 boxes above, you're eligible!**
(Note: Being eligible to apply does not guarantee you a place in a DPP *Higher Nitec* course.)

If you have offered GCE O-Level examination subjects in 2022, you may refer to this table for the equivalent grade to compute your ELMAB3 aggregate:

3. How do I Apply?

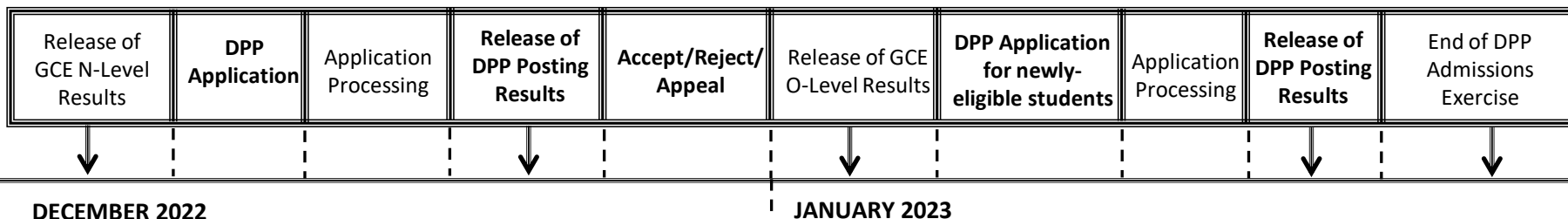
- Upon release of the GCE N-Level results, all DPP-eligible students may apply for DPP *Higher Nitec* courses via the ITE website (<https://www.ite.edu.sg>).
- You may select up to 12 course choices.
- Remember to provide updated contact details in your application to allow ITE to contact you if necessary.

4. How Will I be Informed of the Outcome?

- You should check your DPP posting results online on the morning of the release of the DPP posting results.
- You will then have to indicate if you wish to accept/reject/appeal the offer.
- If you do not accept the offer by the stipulated date, it will become void and you will be required to continue with your classes in Sec 5 or with your *Nitec* or 3-year *Higher Nitec* course if your application via JIE 'N' is successful

5. What Happens Next?

Upon accepting your DPP offer, you will attend a 10-week DPP preparatory programme that will start in Jan 2023.

Eligible 4N(A) students for DPP will receive a copy of Form N inviting them to apply for DPP.

DPP-Eligible applicants can apply using their GCE N-Level results and O-Level prelim results to submit up to 12 course choices in their online application for DPP.

Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) posting results

School candidates who are only interested to apply for DPP using their GCE N-Level results in December 2022 and have accepted the DPP offer do not have to report to school for Secondary 5.

School candidates who do not have a confirmed place in the DPP should report to their secondary schools in 2023 for Secondary 5.

Newly eligible DPP applicants may apply in January 2022 after the release of the 2022 GCE O-Level Exam results.

POLYTECHNIC FOUNDATION PROGRAMME (PFP)

Essential Things You Need to Know

1. What is the PFP?

- A foundation year at the polytechnics that:
 - Prepares well-performing Sec 4N(A) students for progression into respective polytechnic diploma courses
 - Serves as an alternative to Sec 5
- Conducted over two academic semesters at the polytechnics
- Students must pass all PFP modules in order to progress to their respective, pre-selected diploma courses.

2. Am I Eligible for PFP 2023?

You are eligible for the PFP if you:

- Sat for GCE N-Level exams as a school candidate in 2022
- Have obtained an ELMAB3 aggregate of 12 points or less (before deduction of CCA bonus points)
- Met course-specific entry requirements as listed on the PFP website

If you can check all 3 boxes above, you're eligible!
(Note: Eligibility does not guarantee you a place in a PFP course)

If you had offered GCE O-Level examination subjects in 2022, you may refer to this table for the equivalent grade to compute your ELMAB3 aggregate:

3. How do I Apply?

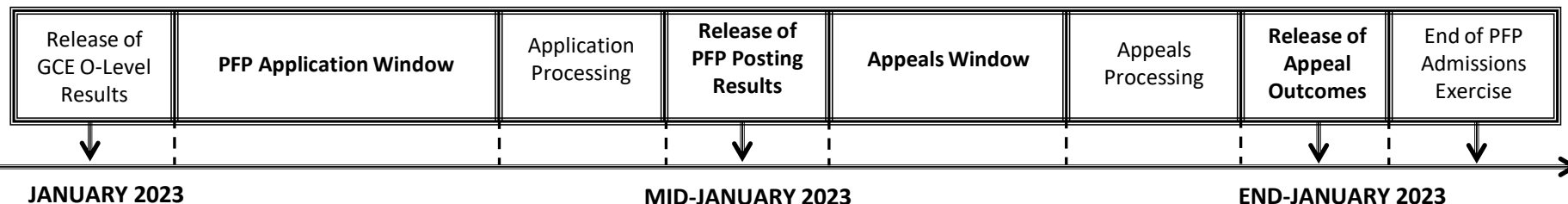
- Upon release of the GCE O-Level results, all PFP-eligible students will receive Form P containing a PFP PIN that allows them to apply for the PFP at this [link](#).
- You may select up to five course choices.
- Remember to provide updated contact details in your application to allow the polytechnics to contact you if necessary.
(Note: You should continue to attend Sec 5 from 3 January 2023 while applying for PFP.)

4. How Will I be Informed of the Outcome?

- You should log in to the PFP portal to check your application outcomes on the day of PFP posting results release.
- You will then have to indicate if you wish to accept/reject/appeal the offer.
- If you do not select any option, your offer will become invalid and you will be required to continue with your classes in Sec 5.
(Note: If your appeal is successful, your original offer will be void regardless of whether you accept the new PFP offer.)

5. What Happens Next?

- If you accept your offer, you will receive an enrolment package from the polytechnics in February/March 2023.
- The PFP year will start in April 2023.

Eligible students will receive a copy of **Form P** inviting them to apply for the PFP after the release of the 2022 GCE O-Level results.

It will include the following:

- Computed raw **ELMAB3** aggregate scores **excluding CCA points**
- List of PFP courses students are eligible to apply for
- A unique Pin code

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Pathway 3 : PFP

Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) posting results

School candidates who are only interested to apply for PFP using their GCE N-Level results in December 2022 and GCE O-Level results in January 2023 have to report to school for Secondary 5.

They will withdraw from Secondary 5 on Friday, 27 January 2023, if their application to PFP is successful.



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DPP and PFP

For students who are interested in BOTH the DPP and PFP:

Students will progress to Sec 5 first. Eligible students can apply for both DPP and PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2023.

If their applications to the PFP and DPP are successful, they can only accept 1 course offer. Students who accept both DPP and PFP offers will have both offers voided.

If the student initially accepted the DPP offer and now wishes to accept his/her PFP offer then he/she **MUST withdraw from the DPP course first before accepting the PFP offer.**



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DPP and PFP

For students who are interested in BOTH the DPP
and PFP:

Students will withdraw from Secondary 5 on **Friday 27 January 2023** if the application to either DPP / PFP is successful.

Many of those who have taken these alternative pathways to pursue post secondary education have done well.

Ultimately you need to consider the type of education that suits your learning style and interests.

Do seek advice and guidance on expectations and preparation for the academic demands of Sec 5 and the other pathways to make an informed decision.
