

- Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase (Final Top-up Phase) between <u>11 Jan to 19</u> Jan 2023 and 27 Jan to 8 Feb 2023 for courses with vacancies. 

# Pathway 1 Early Admission Exercise (ITE EAE) for N(A) students

## **ITE EAE Offers to applicants**

Students who accepted the offer in August and have received a confirmed ITE EAE offer would be indicated as "successful" and would be able to check the course and college that they are posted to.



### **ITE EAE Offers to applicants**

Applicants who have accepted ITE EAE offers and have received the Confirmation offers are to honour the offers. The Confirmation offers will be made known to the students during the release of the N-Level results.

Do not apply for 2-Year *Nitec and* 3-Year *Higher Nitec* courses for 2022 Joint Intake Exercise (JIE ITE). You will not be eligible, as you already have a place through the EAE.

### **ITE EAE Offers to applicants**

ITE will also be contacting students about the status of their ITE EAE offers via (i) mobile phones or (ii) electronic mail. However, in the event that students do not receive the updates from ITE due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g. mobile number has changed since ITE EAE application), they would still be able to check-in with their schools on their ITE EAE offer status.



### **ITE EAE Offers to applicants**

Students who did not meet the minimum entry requirements (MERs) and had their ITE EAE offer revoked would be indicated as "unsuccessful".

They are allowed to apply for the 2-Year *Nitec* and 3-Year *Higher Nitec* courses via the 2022 Joint Intake Exercise (JIE ITE).



### **ITE EAE Offers to applicants**

Both successful and unsuccessful ITE EAE applicants can apply for Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) after the GCE N-Level results and/or Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) after the GCE O-Level results, if they qualify.





# Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) posting results

School candidates who are only interested to apply for PFP using their GCE N-Level results in December 2022 and GCE O-Level results in January 2023 have to report to school for Secondary 5.

They will withdraw from Secondary 5 on Friday, 27 January 2023, if their application to PFP is successful.



### **DPP** and **PFP**

For students who are interested in <u>BOTH the DPP and</u> <u>PFP</u>:

Students will progress to Sec 5 first. Eligible students can apply for both DPP and PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2023.

If their applications to the PFP and DPP are successful, they can only accept 1 course offer. Students who accept both DPP and PFP offers will have both offers voided.

If the student initially accepted the DPP offer and now wishes to accept his/her PFP offer then he/she **MUST** withdraw from the DPP course first before accepting the PFP offer.





#### For students who are interested in **BOTH the DPP** and PFP:

Students will withdraw from Secondary 5 on **Friday 27 January 2023** if the application to either DPP / PFP is successful.

### Pathway 4 : Secondary 5 GCE O-Level

#### Eligibility for promotion to Sec 5 Consider options carefully!

There are many suitable pathways that *most of* those eligible for Sec 5 can consider, such as DPP or PFP.

Many of those who have taken these alternative pathways to pursue post secondary education have done well.
