Release of 2021 GCE O-Level Examination Results

Dear Parents

Please take note of the following important information related to the release of the GCE O-Level Results on Wednesday 12 January 2022 at 2.00 pm.

- 1) Only school candidates collecting their results will be allowed entry into the school premises via the school main gate/ security post, and they will be expected to observe the Safe Management Measures (SMMs) in place. They are reminded to bring their SafeEntry token / mobile phone with the SafeEntry app.
- 2) All school candidates are reminded to be in full school uniform and proper grooming.
- 3) All school candidates should also bring along their JAE Information Booklet that was issued in September 2021. In the event that they have misplaced their booklet, the pdf version can be found here.



4) All school candidates are to report from 1.30 pm to 1.50 pm to the following classrooms.

- 5) School candidates issued with the Ministry of Health's Health Risk Warning will be allowed to collect their results in person if they test negative using the Antigen Rapid Test (ART) on the day of the results release before going to school. They will need to show a picture with the negative test results (with their name and the date the test was administered) to Mr Azuan Tan at the canteen before proceeding to the classroom.
- 6) School candidates who are unwell or are required to self-isolate due to a positive COVID-19 test result should not return to school to collect their results. These students may check their results online via Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board's (SEAB) Candidates Portal from 2.45 pm on 12 January 2022. - 6) School candidates who are eligible for Singpass can use their Singpass account to access SEAB's Candidates Portal. School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from 7 January 2022. SEAB's Candidates Portal will be accessible from 12 January to 26 January 2022.

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7) School candidates who are unable to collect their results in person should inform their Form Teachers, and can appoint a proxy to collect a physical copy of their results, GCE O-Level Certificate and materials on their behalf. Proxies are required to produce their NRIC / identification document and a letter of authorization for the school's verification when collecting the results, Certificate and materials. The proxy form can be found on page (i) of the 2022 JAE Information Booklet. The collection period is from Wednesday, 12 January 2022, 4.00 pm – Tuesday, 18 January 2022, 12.00 pm.

The social and emotional support you provide will be especially valuable and crucial in helping our teens manage their emotions and be positive when deciding on their next steps. Continue to have open conversations with your teen about their interests and choices and build their pathways together.
